Today is the final day for bills to be passed out of policy committees. The pace this week has been frantic as advocates attempt to secure committee attention to one of the thousands of bills that have been introduced. The timeline next moves to February 27 which is the deadline for fiscal issues to be passed from committee. Exempt from both of these dates are those matters necessary to implement the budget.

This week's report reflects the status of issues until mid-morning on Friday.

The major news this week is the emergence of a Senate Transportation Plan. The 16 year, \$15 billion package relies on an 11.7 cent increase in the gas tax as well as various fee increases. The package was negotiated by a bi-partisan sub group of the larger Senate Transportation Committee. While there is not yet consensus on the various elements, it has passed out of the Senate Transportation Committee. The next stop will be consideration by the full Senate.
