This week the Washington State Legislature focused on committee hearings of bills passed from the opposite House. The Senate is considering House bills and the House considering Senate bills. The major news of the week is that the House is delaying release of the budget proposal for at least a week. Rumors suggest the House budget will rely on new tax revenue including the capital gains tax proposal and the Cap and Trade proposal both released by the Governor earlier this year. Both of these tax measures are expected to be modified from the original proposal but no details have yet been released.

SB 5501-Animal Cruelty-The bill was heard in House Judiciary this week.

Minimum Wage/Paid Sick Leave-proposals passed by the House to increase the minimum wage to \$12.00 over four years and to require employers of over 4 full time employees to provide paid sick leave are now in the Senate It is unclear if the Senate will act on these proposals. The minimum wage advocates are threatening an initiative if the issue is not addressed by the legislature.
